

## **GUARANTOR AGREEMENT**

## FOR RESIDENTIAL LETTINGS

## **IMPORTANT**

- This is a contract by which the Landlord agrees to grant a tenancy in consideration of the Guarantor's Agreement to act as surety for that Tenancy Agreement.
- This agreement is for use with the letting of residential property and their associated tenancies.
   As such, this is a legal document and should not be used without adequate knowledge of the law of Landlord and Tenant.
- The Guarantor must be a UK resident over the age of 21 and have sufficient income to cover the Tenant's financial responsibilities. The Channel Islands are not a part of the UK.
   As such, we cannot accept a Guarantor that resides in Jersey, Guernsey and/or the Isle of Man.
- It is essential that the Guarantor has read a copy of the proposed Tenancy Agreement
  and is given adequate opportunity to read both documents before signing. Click the link below
  to read an example copy of the Tenancy Agreement. The Tenant will have been emailed a copy
  of the Tenancy Agreement via DocuSign which they will need to forward to the Guarantor.

- Drake & Co cannot accept emailed/scanned or digitally signed Guarantor Agreements.
   The Guarantor Agreement must be printed, signed by hand, and witnessed by a third party e.g. a friend/relative. The Tenant cannot act as a witness to their Guarantor. Please post the completed agreement with the 'wet ink signature' to Drake & Co's office address (see page 2).
- The Guarantor must provide copies of photo ID which displays their date of birth, current address and proof of signature e.g. a driving licence, to accompany the completed agreement. Please either attach a photocopy of the ID to the agreement when posting this, or email a photo of the ID to Drake & Co using <a href="mailto:info@drakes.co.uk">info@drakes.co.uk</a>. Alternative documents include a copy of a passport along with a utility bill showing proof of address within the last three months.

This Guarantor Agreement creates a binding legal contract. If you do not fully understand the nature of the agreement, then it is recommended that you take independent legal advice before signing.

In consideration of this, the Guarantor agrees to act for the Tenant(s) should they fail, for any reason, to meet the financial commitments arising from the Tenancy Agreement entered into in respect of the Property.</li> <li>This Guarantor Agreement refers to the current tenancy being undertaken by the above named individual tenant and any extension or renewal of that tenancy. All references to the Landlord herein shall be deemed to include the Landlord's Agent or any person authorised to act on the Landlord's behalf.</li> <li>The Guarantor undertakes to pay to the Landlord from the date of this Agreement from time to time the Rent within 7 days of receipt of a written demand from the Landlord or his Agent addressed to the Guarantor if the above named Tenant only following demand has not paid the amount being demanded when it was due under the Tenancy Agreement.</li> <li>The Guarantor shall pay and make good to the Landlord on demand all reasonable losses and expenses of the Landlord incurred as a result of default by the above named Tenant in the performance or observance of the above named Tenant's covenants under the Tenancy Agreement. Any failure of the Landlord in demanding or collecting the Rent when it falls due, and any time to pay which may be given to the Tenant by the Landlord shall not release the Guarantor or in any way affect the liability of the Guarantor under this agreement. Should the Guarantor die during the currency of this agreement, the Guarantor's estate will be liable as surety and co-principal debtor.</li> <li>Where the Rent, or any portion of it, is paid by housing benefit or other benefit scheme, the Guarantor agrees to pay the Landlord or Agent for the amount of any claims arising from overpayment, which may be made by the local authority in relation to the specified Tenant(s). Such overpayments may occur at any time, either during the tenancy or within six years thereafter.</li> <li>If the ten</li></ol>
